## Getting the Year Off to a Quality Start

As the calendar changes, so do measures of quality and program goals. Like a New Year's resolution, changes reflect on the past year and target improvement. Therefore, it is important to identify the 2018 programs and quality measures for your practice and patient population.

The best path to improved performance requires that the physician office practice team members know the goals of the programs and the quality metrics which their practice will work on. Just as we encourage our patients to take SMART goals, we must also plan specific actions to achieve the program and quality measure goals. This knowledge empowers the physician office team members to consider how their work, and potentially the changes in their daily work, supports the quality measures and goals of the practice.

If you are unsure what has changed for 2018 or new to your practice, this is the perfect time to investigate. Here are a few tips:

Learn about resources in your practice related to quality including types of quality reports and how are the quality reports shared. Ask "Who are the quality experts in my practice? For example, program or quality experts might be an office manager, a care coordinator, or a practice transformation coach.

Learn which programs are important to your practice. If your office is a Patient Centered Medical Home (PCMH), which areas is your office working on this year?

Michigan primary care practices may be participating in multiple programs and/or demonstration programs. For 2018, several care management programs, including Provider Delivered Care Management and the State Innovation Model PCMH, require more patients to be served by care management. How will your team get there? Will you work on patient engagement? New referrals? Setting aside more time for warm handoffs or team conferences?

While other programs, like Comprehensive Primary Care Plus (CPC+), focus on patient targeting and complexity. Will you have new tools this year? Do you know how to get them?
