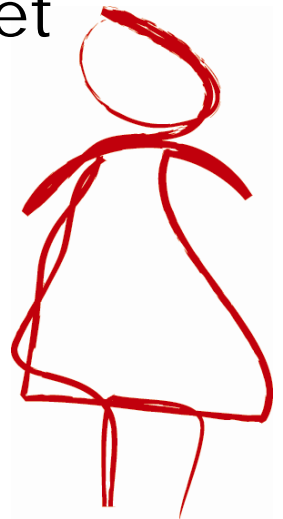

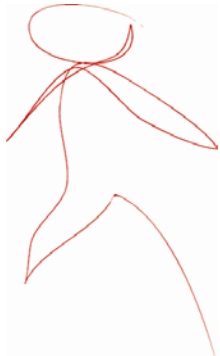

Families who have children from 3 to 26 years old with disabilities receiving special education services

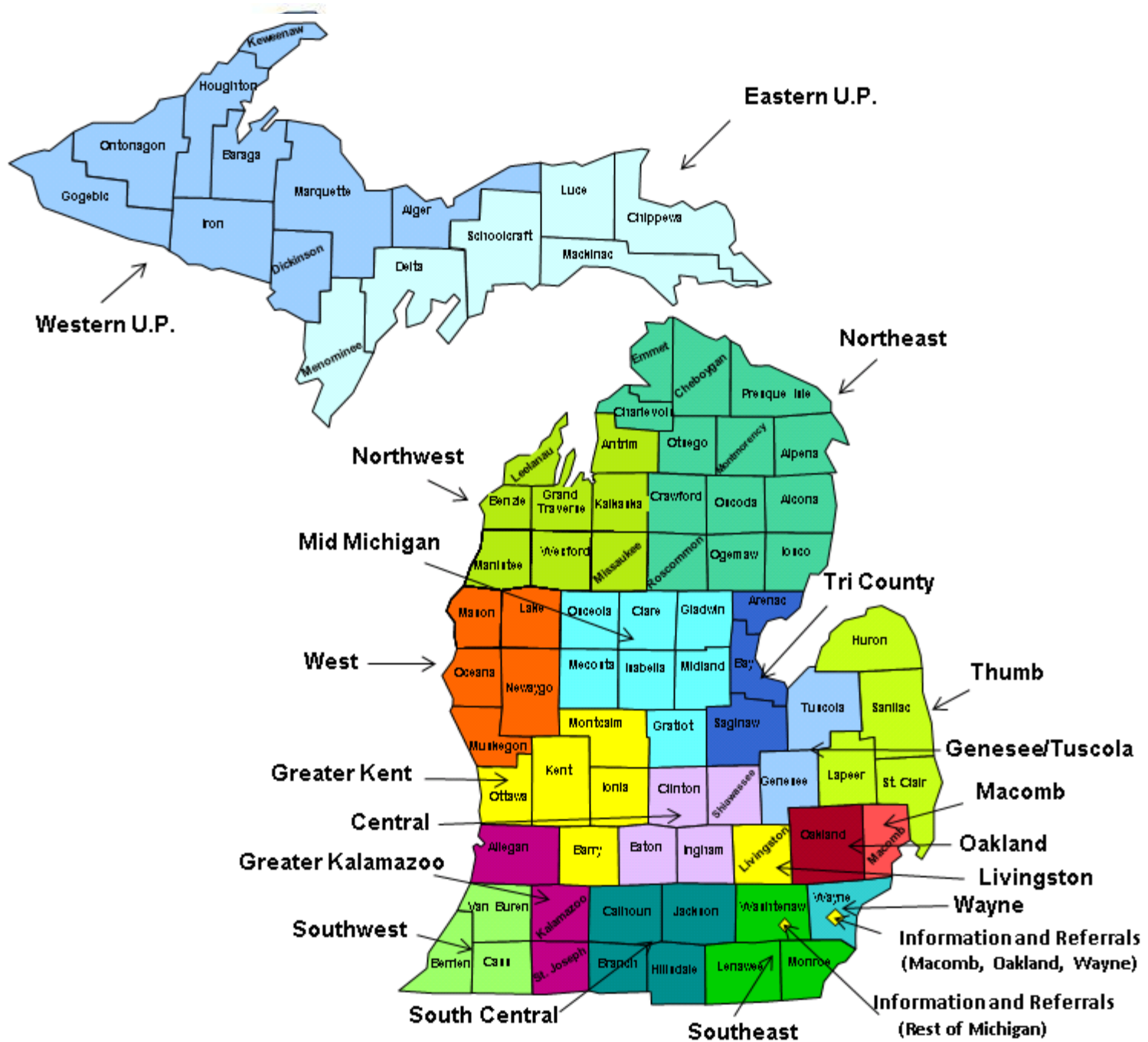
